1. CALL TO ORDER

4. BUSINESS PLANNING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

b. <u>5 Year Capital Plan (2021-2025)</u>

The 5 Year Capital Plan and the Operating Budgets were reviewed by the Committee on February 3, 2021. The Interim Senior Manager, Finance and Administration summarized the key elements of the 5 Year Capital Plan. Overall, the proposed 2021 Capital budget is 60% lower than the average capital budget over the last 4 years. Due to the COVID-19 impacts, staff did an extensive review of all existing projects and were able to defer some projects and return \$300,000 back to the reserves to fund future capital projects. The 5-year plan will be revised each year and a placeholder of \$500,000 is included each year from 2022 to 2025 for long term facility maintenance.

The Committee will table the Capital Plan resolution after review of the Operating Budget.

c. 2021 Operating Budget

The Interim Senior Manager, Finance & Administration summarized the information in the budget package, noting that the COVID-19 pandemic has significant impacts on the overall operations. Procedures put in place, such as social distancing and additional cleaning make the building more expensive to operate.

In response to the Board's inquiry on expiring sponsorships, staff shared the discussion from the Business Planning Committee meeting. Just recently staff were successful in renewing the licensing agreement with the Canadian Olympic Committee with favorable results regarding the rights of the Olympic brand. Although this will enhance flexibility in sponsorship sales, the market is also faced with new challenges such as COVID-19 impacts and the sponsors' shifting of directions. Staff will work with the City to look at resources and approach to the sponsorship program but it is expected to be more

difficult to pursuit than 10 years ago when the Oval was a new Olympic Venue with all the cachet associated with the Games.

In response to the Board's inquiry regarding any role to play of Oval to vaccination of COVID-19, it was noted that the City of Richmond is working with the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority in the support of vaccine rollout across the city and at this point, the Oval is not being considered as a potential site clinic given the various health activities and programs taking place at the Oval is also important for the community and the Health Authority do not want to interrupt these services.
